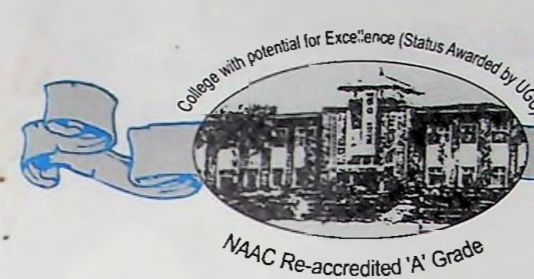
Following suggestions are given by CS. Athavale Sir:-
